Busabout appreciate your continued support and patience with the ongoing road work on Narellan Road for the Narellan Road Upgrade Project. The opening of Gregory Hills Drive in October 2017, connecting Gregory Hills to Campbelltown, has eased congestion along Narellan Road significantly. This, combined with the opening of more lanes along Narellan Road, has seen a significant increase in buses running on-time. As the Narellan Road Project nears completion, we hope to see services back on schedule with minimal disruptions.
